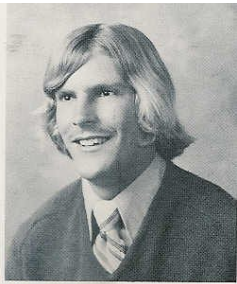


Ticket Sales have been AMAZING!

Project #2 - Slide show at the reunion!

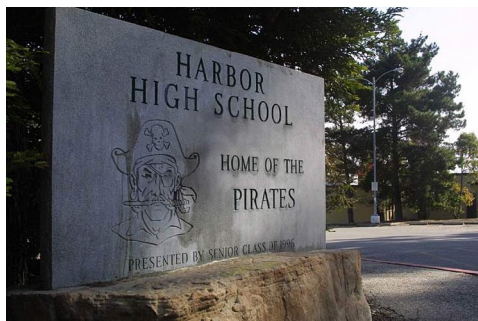
